Monstrances - Radiances - Reliquaries - *Jajanchner*

These special containers for consecrated host, blessed wafer (*nushkar*) or for the relics of saints and sacred objects have been part of orthodox tradition since ancient times. Their artistry and splendor are both a means to properly "hold" and to physically symbolize the "radiance" of the sacred item. They are used in worship on holy altars to enhance festive days, as well as by the celebrant in procession and as a means to bless the faithful.

383	Vestry Altar - <i>Khorhrtaran Seghani</i> - At which the celebrant priest begins his prayers in preparation for liturgy and puts on his liturgical vestments. White finish with gold wood-carved decorative applications. Includes storage drawers for vestments.	4000
415	Biblical Epigraph - main exterior formal entry to the Church - Armenian & English carved in granite	5000
134	Bowl For Butter (Foot Washing Service) Silver Plate 2.5 High X 5" Round Base	25
